

## GREEN PROTOCOL

The implementation of Green Protocol in Shri B.P.B.Arts And M.H.G.Commerce College, Unjha is an inhibitive to fulfill out institution's mission to initiate and promote programmes that eco-justice. The following Green Protocol is proposed to be employed in the college.

1. Foster a culture of responsible dining by avoiding food wastage.
2. Encourage the use of stainless steel utensils to carry food and steel water bottles.
3. Started E College magazine/Newsletter to minimize the use of paper.
4. Encourage students to use bags, pencil boxes, purses made of cloth to reduce rexine waste which is generally non-recyclable.
5. Promote recycling/reuse of textile waste.
6. Encourage students to serve as brand ambassadors of eco-friendly alternatives to plastic carry bags provided by the Green club.
7. Promote the use of ink pens to prevent accumulation o plastic waste.
8. Avoid plastic covering and rexine-binding on project reports and records.
9. Avoid the use of non-biodegradable materials like thermocol.
10. Encourage the use of e-copies of brochures, programme notices, invitation letters to be send via e-mails, Whatsapp and messages. Avoid of minimize the use of printed material.
11. Avoid bouquets draped in plastic covers during functions on campus. welcome the dignitaries with a single flower, a sapling, book/s or a cloth bag.
12. Use electronic College Android Application, display boards and cloth banners etc. for seminars workshops and other programmes, avoiding flex.
13. Avoid plastic files and pens for seminars and workshops. Encourage jute paper files and pencils.
14. Avoid disposable cups and plates in functions instead, use utensils that can be washed and reused.
15. Implement green protocol in the Convocation ceremony of the college by prohibiting the usage of plastic carry bags.
16. Segregate the waste generated on campus into bio degradable. non-bio degradable and hazardous categories.
17. Treat bio-degradable waste at source.

18. Clean, segregate and hand over plastic and paper to scrap dealers. Avoid burning them.
19. Store electrical and electronic waste and hand a over for recycling.
20. Post reminders to students and teachers in every room including bathroom hallway, and lunchroom to turn off lights, unplug energy draining devices when not in use and save water in everyday use.
21. Constitute Green protocol teams to conduct awareness sessions for class leaders, students and staff.
22. Encourage students to use and promote energy efficient LED bulbs. Installed LED bulbs in classrooms.
23. Set up solar panels within the college to meet its energy needs.
24. Promote a social entrepreneurship unit to manufacture and popularise cloth bags.
25. Inspire students to plant and nurture organic vegetables trees.
26. Organize clean up drive, Swachhata Abhiyan and planting days, also observe important environment days.
27. Make trekking camps, nature camps and environment studies a part of the curriculum.
28. Organize awareness programmes for the public on various environment concerns.
29. Produce documentaries on the hazards of plastic to raise public awareness.
30. Conduct training workshops for various students to stitch trendy cloth alternatives to plastic carry bags.
31. Produce documentaries on the manufacture of cloth bags as self training tools for the public.
32. Promote the observance of green protocol in local festivals.
33. Support local governments, civic bodies in designing and implementing green initiatives.
34. Support the green initiatives of Government of Gujarat as well as Union Government.
